STEWARTS BURNBY HALL GARDENS GOLDEN JUBILEE RESTORATION PROJECT

2017 to 2019 sees an exciting three-year project, supported by the Heritage Lottery Fund, to renovate the Gardens and maintain their unique heritage for future generations to enjoy.

This will comprise:

- The restoration of the Upper and Lower Lakes.
- The preservation and development of the National Collection of Nymphaea.
- The restoration of the Rock Garden.
- The recreation of an Edwardian potting shed, now open on our guided tours.
- The creation of a bespoke Learning Zone on site.
- The enhancement of the Gardens' heritage.

During the 2018 season, the Rock Garden will, by necessity, remain fallow to allow for extensive re-planting in the autumn and we apologise for any inconvenience this might cause.
