Walk Highlights

- Two sandy beaches with facilities - look for Langland's colourful beach huts from the 1920's and 1930's.
- Spectacular views over the Bristol Channel to North Devon and beyond.
- Choughs, skylarks, peregrines and buzzards can be seen along this walk.
- Wildflowers like gorse, thrift and red and white campions are particularly colourful in Spring.

Start & Finish: Bus stop on Caswell Road opposite Caswell Drive, Newton.

Distance/time: About 2 miles, 1-2 hours.

Terrain: Surface varies from hard and smooth, to soft and uneven earth. There are steps but no stiles.

Safety Information: The route crosses the golf course - beware of airborne golf balls! The path runs close to cliffs and slopes along coast.

Safet Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the conditions and season.

Refreshments: Refreshments at Langland Bay and Caswell Bay.

Public Toilets: Langland Bay, Caswell Bay.

Walk back the way you arrived on the bus for a few yards onto Caswell Road. Turn left and after a few yards turn right along Hillgrove (private road, but public footpath).

Follow the track as it turns right and crosses part of the golf course. Follow the path until you reach the steps leading down to the coastal path.

Turn right and carefully walk down the steps until you reach the coast path. Turn left and follow the path around the coast to Langland Bay.

Walk past the first few beach huts on your left then turn left up the lane away from the Bay to the bottom of Brynfield Road. Turn left and follow the lane towards Langland Bay Golf Club.

Before the clubhouse turn right past the 'No Entry' sign and follow the narrow path across and then beside the fairway of the golf course.

Here you will emerge onto a track. Cross over the track and up the bank onto a second track. Cross this track and climb a short flight of steps onto a third track, which you followed earlier.

Turn right and follow the track, retracing your steps back to Caswell Road. Turn left then right to return to the bus stop.

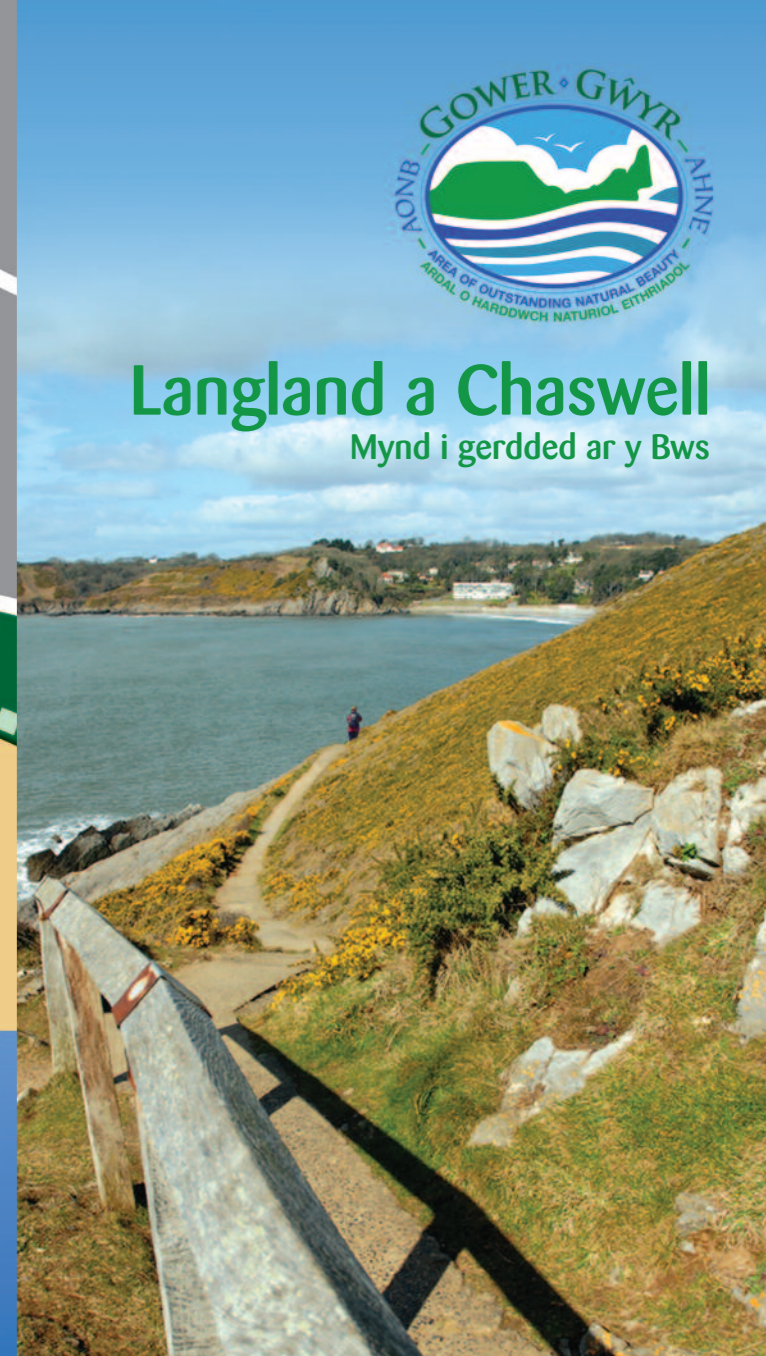

Pellter/amser: Tir:

Tua 2 filltir, 1-2 awr. Yr wyneb yn amrywio o dir caled a llyfn, i dir meddal ac anwastad. Mae grisiau ond dim camfeydd.

Gwybodaeth Diogelwch:

Mae'r llwybr yn croesi'r cwrs golff - gwyliwch rhag y peli golff yn hedfan drwy'r awyr! Mae'r llwybr ger ymyl y clogwyni ac yn gwyro ar hyd yr arfordir.

Lluniaeth:

Lluniaeth ym Mae Langland a Bae Caswell.

Toiledau Cyhoeddus:

- Ewch yn ôl ychydig lathenni ar hyd y ffordd y gwnaethoch gyrraedd ar y bws i Heol Caswell. Trowch i'r chwith ac wedi ychydig o lathenni, trowch i'r dde ar hyd Hillgrove (heol breifat, ond llwybr cyhoeddus).
- Dilynwch y trac wrth iddo droi i'r dde a chroesi rhan o'r cwrs golff. Dilynwch y llwybr nes i chi gyrraedd y grisiau sy'n arwain i lawr i lwybr yr arfordir.

- Trowch i'r dde a cherdded i lawr y grisiau'n ofalus nes i chi gyrraedd llwybr yr arfordir. Trowch i'r chwith a dilyn y llwybr o gwmpas yr arfordir i Fae Langland.
- Cerddwch hebio i'r cytiâu traeth cyntaf ar eich chwith ac yna troi i'r chwith i fyni'r lôn i ffwrdd o'r Bae i waelod Heol Brynfield. Trowch i'r chwith a dilyn y lôn tuag at Glwb Golf Bae Langland. Cyn adeilad y clwb, trowch i'r dde hebio i'r arwydd 'Dim Mynediad' a dilyn y llwybr cul ar draws ac yna wrth ymyl ffordd glir y cwrs golff.
- Yma, byddwch yn dod allan ar drac. Croeswch y trac ac i fyni'r banc i ail drac. Croeswch y trac a dringo ychydig o risiau i drydydd trac, y buoch yn ei ddilyn yn gynharach.
- Trowch i'r dde a dilyn y trac, gan ailroedio'r llwybr yn ôl i Heol Caswell. Trowch i'r chwith ac yna i'r dde i ddychwelyd i'r safle bws.
