Titanic Belfast, a world-class visitor attraction and events venue is rising above Titanic's slipway to become a truly spectacular addition to the Belfast skyline.

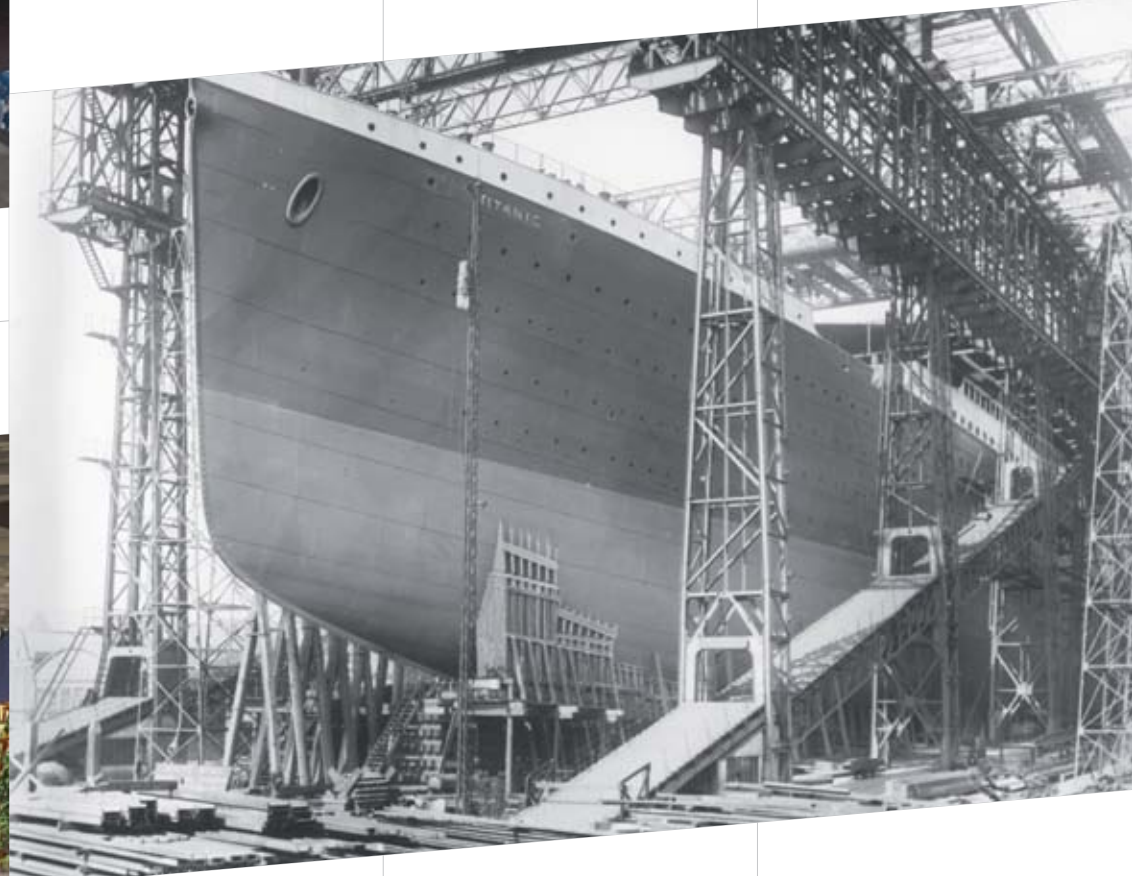
