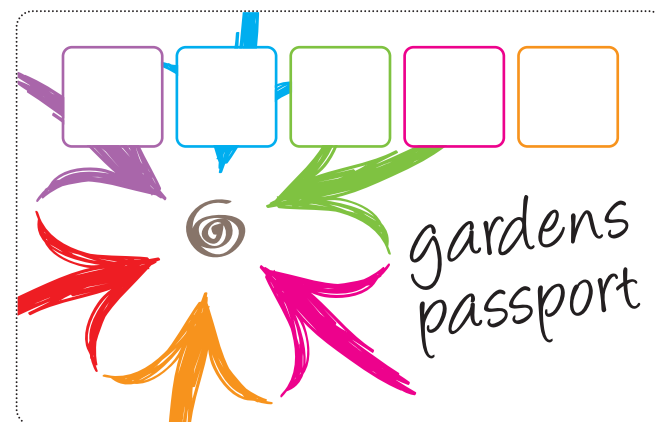
As the warm ocean air of the Gulf Stream washes over our corner of Scotland a rich diversity of plants flourish, putting on spectacular displays of colour throughout the year.

One of the 'showpieces of Galloway', these historic gardens, surrounded by water, contain 75 acres of terraced earthworks and magnificent avenues. They include a 2 acre lily-pond, rare and exotic plants, 21 Champion trees, two Castles, a Walled Garden and stunning displays of rhododendrons, azaleas and camellias.

Ardwell Gardens

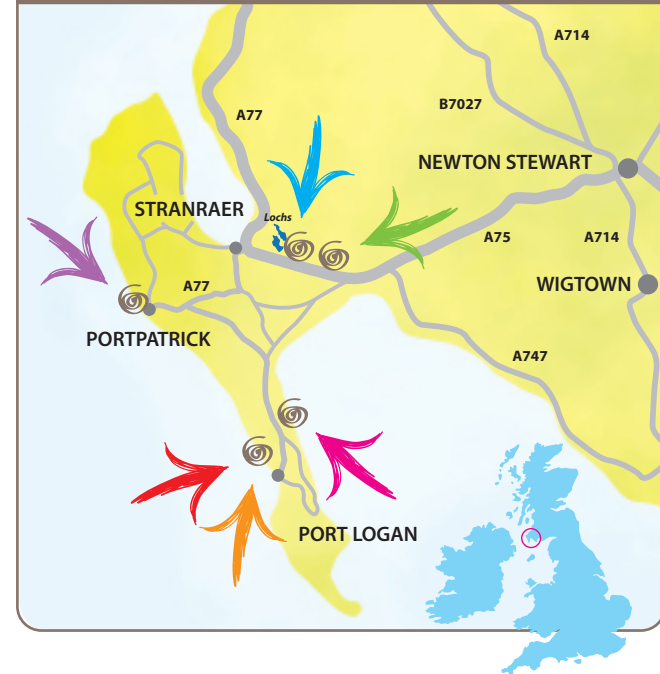
