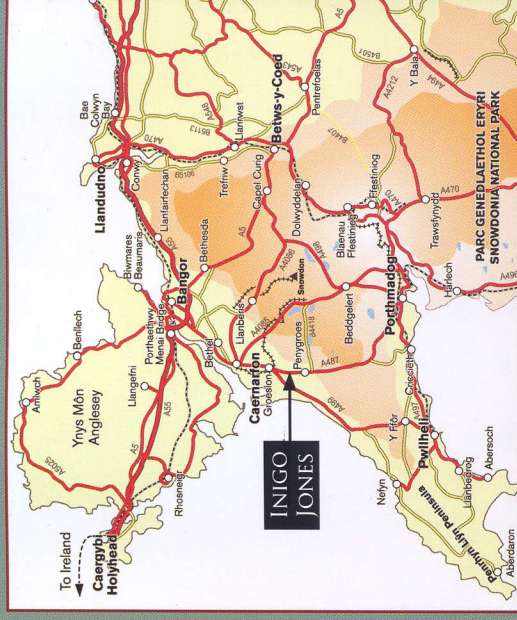

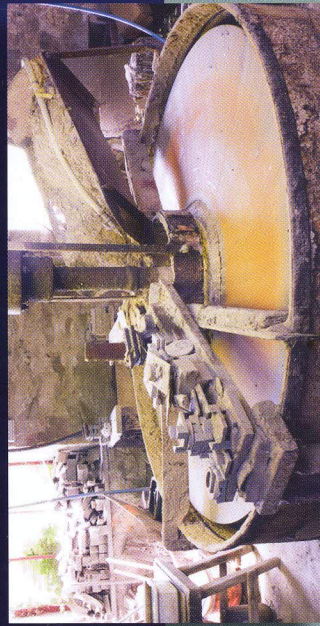
Enter the fully operational workshops to gain a fascinating insight into the enduring story of a product which has shaped the world.
